Course Information & Teaching Methods;

This course is suitable for beginners and also those with some experience.

It is aimed at getting you started on a project if you are a beginner, and developing more complex upholstery skills if you are experienced.

Upholstery, Next Steps is a good way to get stuck into a **small** project, with enough information and techniques provided to enable you to carry on with the project at home, and/or carry on at a following course. Beginners should bring along a simple project, for example a foot stool or a drop in seat.

The course is taught by one-to-one contact between the student and tutor within the group setting of the workshop and tutor demonstrations, as appropriate.

Equipment;

The Arts & Crafts Centre has a heavy craft room with work benches and trestles suitable to this craft.

- A pin hammer
- A tack lifter
- Material scissors
- Pins
- Tape measure
- Upholstery pincers, (if available, this can be discussed with the tutor in week 1)

- Pencil or pen
